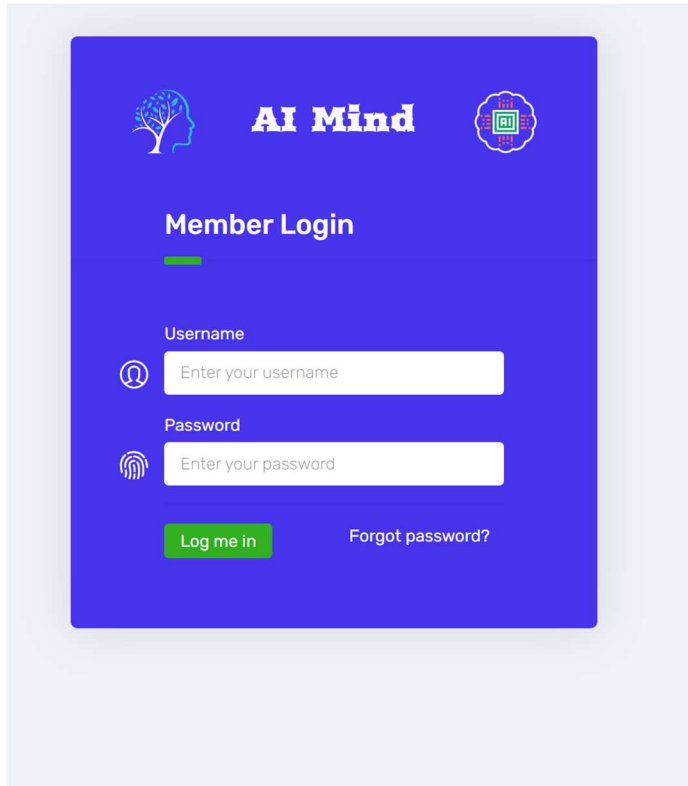


# Log into your account

The first thing to do after you log in your account through this link.

Your username and password are sent to your email account.



## Adding your API key

The first thing to do after you log in is to set your OpenAI API key. This can be done easily by clicking on your profile image in the top right corner, then selecting “Profile” or following the link in the appearing notification which appears when you do not have any API Key set.



Here you can change your name and password to if you would like and add your API Key to. Please note, that if you are getting an error related to password when saving your profile with your API key, please make sure that both password fields are empty or both password fields have your current, or your new password. When password is saved in your browser, it might automatically populate one of the password fields, which will trigger the password change function but that needs both password fields filled with the same password.

# Using the application

Using the application is self-explanatory. And there are only a few fields:

You can choose one of the following two modes of data input to generate marketing material. The default setting is “Enter URL”, but you can select “Enter text” also.

- **“Enter URL”**: this means entering a URL for the app to analyze and use for your content. Maximum content depends on your OpenAI API key, but for most people is 8000 tokens for GPT4, 16k for GPT3.5.
- **“Enter text”**: this has the same limits as the option above, but you can type or paste your content directly into this field.

There is also an additional hidden function when you select “Enter text” but do not define any text.

In this instance, the application will generate default general data for the different data types. This also happens when you use the “Enter URL” function but there can’t be any content gathered from the URL or the content is really short without any meaning.

If this happens, you can manually go to the website, copy its content and use the “Enter text” function to add the data.

## Getting your API key

After logging in to your account for the first time, you will see a message to add your OpenAI API key to the application. The application is not able to work without it.

As soon as you add your API key in your profile page, you can see what API's are available for you.

**ChatGPT Plus** is a dedicated application designed for user interactions with OpenAI's GPT-4 model. In contrast, the **OpenAI API** is a developer-focused tool allowing the integration of OpenAI models into applications, such as the AI Brain app.

Having access to ChatGPT Plus does not guarantee GPT-4 access via the OpenAI API. These are separate services, and each requires its own authorization.

To use models in applications via the OpenAI API, an API key is essential. However, the models you can access are dictated by your OpenAI API account settings, not just the presence of an API key.

If you've encountered an error regarding GPT-4 access through the API, you may need to enable this model for your account. Confirm model availability by visiting the [OpenAI Platform](#) and navigating to the "playground" section. If GPT-4 is absent, you can request activation, often involving contacting OpenAI support.

## Error messages

All errors displayed in the red box above your content or in place of the generated content are coming from OpenAI directly. This means that there are issues with your API Key or your API Key's access level.

The Most common error is this one that can happen:

Error! The model `gpt-4` does not exist or you do not have access to it. Learn more: <https://help.openai.com/en/articles/7102672-how-can-i-access-gpt-4>.

This happens when you try to use the GPT-4 content generation but you don't have GPT4 API access. ChatGPT uses the same AI but it is only inside ChatGPT itself, it's a different thing to the API all these apps can use.

Basically, if you spend \$1 in your account (or contact their support) it should be activated.

As you can see, most of the error messages provide additional details from OpenAI so you can get more details from them if needed.
